

Helm Weave

The Helm Weave is a basic but dynamic pattern. It is a great pattern for beginners.



Materials List

18g 6mm inner diameter jumprings (60)

18g 4mm inner diameter jumprings (45)

1 Clasp

Tool List – Don't forget Safety Glasses!

2 pair Wubbers Classic Chain Nose pliers or
Baby Chain Nose pliers

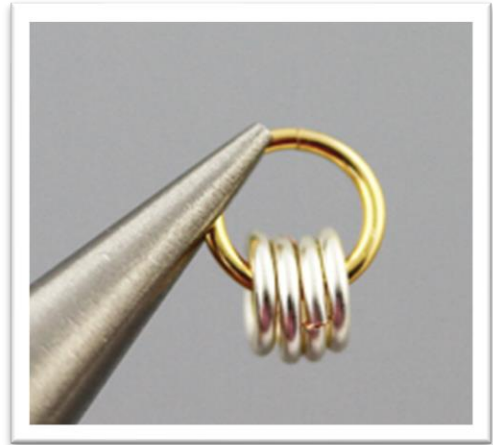
Step one

Begin by closing four small rings. The rest of the rings will need to be opened. You can do that now or as you go along.



Step Two

Scoop up the four small rings with the large ring. Close the large ring.



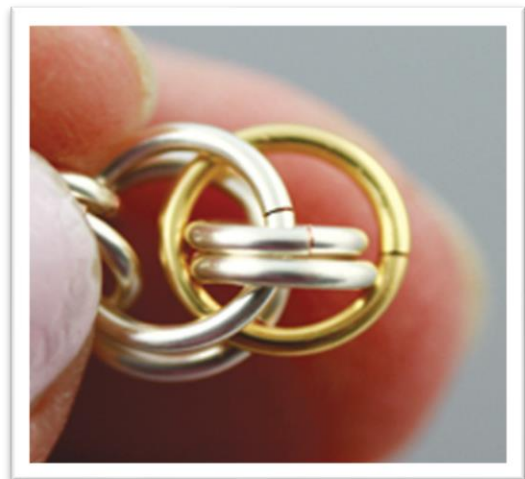
Step Three

Thread a second large ring through the same path. Close the large ring.



Step Four

Thread another large ring through the middle of the previous two large rings, encircling the two small rings. Close the ring.



Step Five

Thread another large ring through the previous two small rings you encircled in step 4. Close the ring.



Step Six

Turn your piece over and repeat step 5 on the back side.



Step Seven

Thread a small ring through the two large rings that were just added. Close the ring. Repeat with another small ring.

Step Eight

Repeat steps 4 through 7 until you have the length of chain you desire.



Step Nine

Thread a small ring through the last pair of small rings and add one end of your clasp before closing.



Step Ten

On the other end of your piece, thread a small ring through the end pair of small rings and add the other end of your clasp before closing.
